Much of El Salvador is poor in the rural area and has limited access to medical and dental care. We will focus on bringing hope and healing to the poorest of poor in El Salvador.



El Salvador may be the smallest country in Central America, but it's certainly one of its most charming. Less touristy than its neighbors, El Salvador is rich in natural beauty, pristine beaches, countless volcanoes, many Maya ruins, a great culture, and a rich history.

We will be providing 4 days of free clinic to the poor people of both the Santiago Nonualco, and San Juan Nonualco, La Paz communities.

During the mission clinic days, we will be staying at a quiet Pacific Ocean beach resort with a pool, that is located on a beautiful black sand beach.

When our mission work is complete, we will adventure on several incredible day trips, and exlore some of the beauty El Salvador has to offer. Included will be a hike to the top of the spectacular Santa Ana Volcano, followed by a visit to the beautiful turquoise Lake Coatepeque. In addition, we will discover and bathe in the wild beauty of El Salvador's Tamanique Waterfalls.

Friday March 20: arrive at El Salvador International Airport (SAL)

You will be picked up and transported to our hotel in Costa del Sol. Depending on what time your flight arrives, you may have time to stop at a roadside stand for some fresh coconut water or grab a traditional pupusa. We will enjoy a team lunch, reception, and our traditional "meds party", followed by an oceanfront sunset dinner.
