Lebanon County Special Olympics is making plans to hold our 8th annual dinner and auction benefit. Held at St. Cecilia's Social Hall on March 9, 2019 the event will feature dinner and silent and live auctions with 100% of the proceeds benefiting Special Olympic athletes in Lebanon County. The success of such an event can often be attributed to sponsors and donors who provide financial support. We are in need of event sponsors, auction item donations, and bottles of wine for our wine pull. Following are the details for each opportunity.

EVENT SPONSORSHIP: As a sponsor you would benefit from exposure through media outlets and promotional efforts directed toward our supporters. Each sponsorship level also includes tickets to the event.

\$2,000 = Platinum sponsor, includes 24 tickets (3 tables) \$500 = Silver sponsor, includes 8 tickets (1 table)
\$1,000 = Gold sponsor, includes 16 tickets (2 tables) \$250 = Bronze sponsor, includes 4 tickets

AUCTION ITEM DONATIONS: We are also in need of merchandise donations for our raffles and auctions. Items such as gift cards, theme baskets, tickets to events, and hand crafted furniture are always popular!

WINE PULL DONATIONS: As a new addition to our event last year this "raffle" has been a huge success! We have sold out quickly! We will be numbering corks corresponding with a bottle of wine and asking for a \$10 donation to pull a cork. The player then receives the bottle that matches the number they pull. Everyone's a winner. Donors and/or business names will be listed on each bottle.

ATTEND & BID: Please feel free to join us for a great evening. Tickets are \$25 per person, \$45 per couple, or \$160 per table of eight.

Last year's event was attended by over 200 people and raised over \$30,000. All funds received remain within Lebanon County directly serving the needs of individuals in our community. Proceeds will be used to cover costs such as transportation, equipment, uniforms, and practice facilities. It's events like these that allow us to continue our mission.
