New Molluscum Treatment

MOLLUSCUM CONTAGIOSUM IS A COMMON CHILDHOOD VIRAL INFECTION WHICH PRIMARILY AFFECTS THE SKIN AND RESULTS IN THE DEVELOPMENT OR SMALL, RAISED PAINLESS BUMPS OR LESIONS

Cannida Antigen refers to a specific type of protein that can be derived from the candida species, specifically Candida albicans and is commonly associated with immune response to fungal infections. By injected Candida albicans to the molluscum directly, the body rejects the virus and clears the skin lesions through immune response!

<u>Insurance Coverage on Vaccines</u>

- Due to our current economic climate, rising costs and poor coverage for insurance,
 Floridians and private practice owners are struggling to get adequate coverage for vaccines and preventative healthcare.
- As a results, we are unable to submit for insurance reimbursement for vaccines from the following insurance carriers: United Healthcare, Tri-Care, or Medicaid
- For patients with other carriers including: Aetna and Blue Cross Blue Shield, we are happy to curtesy submit for insurance, however, we will now be requiring %50 of the cost of vaccines as a cash deposit on the day of service. After reimbursement has be processed, we are happy to add that credit to your account accordingly.
