

Course Summary

This course serves as an introduction for students aspiring to communicate effectively in both spoken and written Arabic. The focus is on Modern Standard Arabic (MSA), recognized as the formal medium of communication in areas such as academia, law, and education. Unlike various dialects, MSA serves as a key to comprehending other regional Arabic variations across many Arab countries.

It is important to acknowledge that achieving complete proficiency in reading and writing requires additional supplementary work.



Course Objectives

This course aims to equip students with the following skills:

- 1. Communicate writing and speaking with other Arabic speakers.
- 2. Understand basic Arabic grammar at the beginner level.
- 3. Develop an Understanding and Appreciation of the Classical Arabic tradition and Culture.

Upon successful completion of this course, students will be able to:

- 1. Become a fluent Arabic reader.
- 2. Write short sentences through dictation activities(Spelling).
- 3. Communicate by using correct grammatical and lexical sentence structures, in both speech and writing.
