It was quite a day. According to the article, this incredible forest started with a single juniper

cutting and was slowly developed over time by master bonsai artist and teacher, John Naka. When John toured, Gold Coast was always on his calendar. The article carefully explains the art of bonsai along with close-up photos of Goshin. John might have been short in stature, but he was a giant in the art of bonsai. His hands were magical, and the height and size of the bonsai forests and individual trees he created made no difference to him, even if they dwarfed him. I, along with those who knew and worked with John, continue to miss him.






