Our trees in smaller pots are more susceptible, but even larger trees may suffer damage when we get below 50 degrees. Now is the time to keep an eye on the thermometer and err on the side of caution when deciding whether to bring trees indoors. We are also approaching the time to repot bald cypress as they go into dormancy.

January's meeting will continue the tradition of featuring Ed Trout and Betty Siskind demonstrating work on a juniper, and the tree will be raffled at the end of the meeting. This is your chance to get a tree worked on by bonsai royalty!

A recent Black Pondo podcast featured an interview with Aarin Packard, current curator of the Pacific Bonsai Museum. Aarin is a self-proclaimed disruptor with a background in art curation, and he is a person to watch as he pushes the envelope. From the LAB project to the World War Bonsai exhibit and the Avant Garden exhibit, he has taken an artcentered approach to bonsai display that breaks tradition.
