On Saturday May 13th, 2023, at 9:00 am, Mike will present a complete set of photographs from the Kokofu-ten Exhibition. Time allowing, he also photographed his visit to Omiya Bonsai Museum, Shunka-en Bonsai Garden (Kunio Kobayashi), Masahiko Kimura's Garden; Uchiku-Tei (Seiji Morimae); Taisho-en Nursery (Taiga Urushibata) and the potters of Tokoname, a Peony Exhibition in Ueno Park, and a visit to Senso-ji Temple (Akasuka).
