

God has been so good to our family. It is getting difficult to name all of the churches we have had the opportunities to minister and present the work in. We have been in 11 churches from May - June and two of those weeks we were in Beach

Park, Illinois for our first tent meeting. We can't believe everything God has been doing with our family! The tent meeting in Illinois went very well! God answered so many prayers while we were there, and the burden we have for the goals of the tent ministry were accomplished! Our goals are to plant churches and/or help churches to grow through winning souls to Christ, while also encouraging the people of the church to get a burden for soul winning! The day after we got to Beach Park, we



went out to around 80 local businesses and put up flyers in any place that would let us. We only had 3 businesses that said no. Most places were happy to post the flyers. One of my favorite things to do is the Bible hand out! We put up a little tent

and hold up signs that say "Free Bible," and people will drive into the parking lot to get a free Bible.

Before we hand them a Bible, we ask them about their salvation. Pastor Brian Petrick was the first one to lead a soul to Christ. The gentleman said, "I never go this way home but for some strange reason I did. I

drove by and saw, "Free Bibles" and something inside me would not let me go so I turned around." That sparked a huge excitement in Pastor Petrick's heart! He

came back and told his church at the meeting about the hand out and more people started to come.

One man from the church, came to the Bible hand out, and before he could get to the tent where the Bibles were, he led a soul to Christ! The last day we were able to go to the Hand out, 19 were saved!

Brianna was able to lead 3 Hispanic people to Christ in Spanish! This was the first time she led



someone to Christ in Spanish. We saw many people just looking for hope, and when they saw the sign for free Bibles, they pulled into the parking lot and started asking questions. It was a very eye opening

experience. We get so discouraged sometimes knocking on doors and feeling like everyone hates Christians and no one cares about their soul. But there are people out there searching for peace, looking to fill the void in their lives. We had the privilege to lead a Spanish guy to the Lord. He knew he was a sinner but the problem was, he didn't think Christ would save

someone like him. He thought there was no hope!! I will never forget the moment he realized that Jesus died for him and that his sin was not too great for God to forgive. With tears in his eyes, he trusted Christ! I picked him up and brought him to the tent meeting where we had an interpreter on standby. After the service he said, "I could not understand the singing but when I heard it, I felt so much peace, and I knew I was where I needed to be." Each night, Bro Craig Bryan gave a salvation message. We had a total of 57 saved during those two weeks at the meeting in Illinois!!! After we left, the pastor followed up on his first convert from the hand out and ended up leading the gentlemen's wife and daughter to the Lord. New people are coming for the Bible hand out, within 3 Saturdays following us leaving, they saw nearly 30 saved! That is what the ministry is about, going into the highways and hedges and compelling men and women, boys and girls, to come to Christ!
