Reminder

All students who have perfect attendance during any given month would be put into a drawing for a chance to win a special prize.

If your student is absent, If your student is going to absent, late or dismissed early caregivers should:

- Call the front office
- Message the classroom teacher
- Follow through with a note.

Caregivers must physically write a note including date(s), the reason for absence, a phone number where a parent or caregiver can be reached, and the parent or caregiver's signature.

We will work with families to ensure that students come to school, but if families are unresponsive or noncommittal then we are legally required to refer the case to the Supervisor of Attendance and truancy court.

If your student has missed more than 80% of school we encourage you to sign up for summer programming below.
