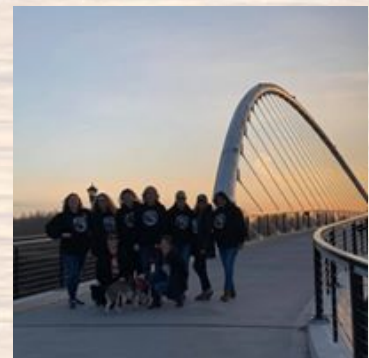

- **Teen Shelter:** We are in the beginning stages of funding a new teen shelter in Salem, OR. Our goal is to have the shelter completed by end of year 2020. There is a real need for another teen shelter in the Salem-Keizer District. Currently, there is only 1 overnight shelter available between Portland and Albany for homeless minors. That home houses 10 minors. It is estimated that there are approximately 250 homeless minors in the Salem-Keizer School District. If you would like to donate, you can do so through United Way and have the funds earmarked for NAWIC Salem.
