A Message from the President

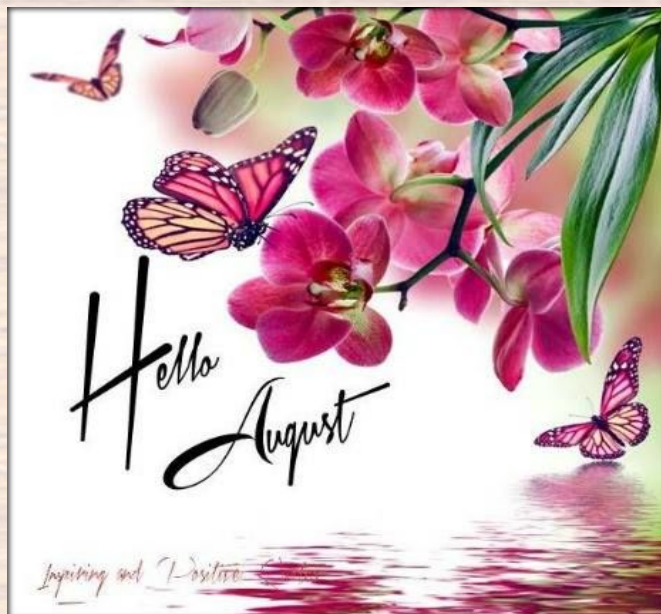

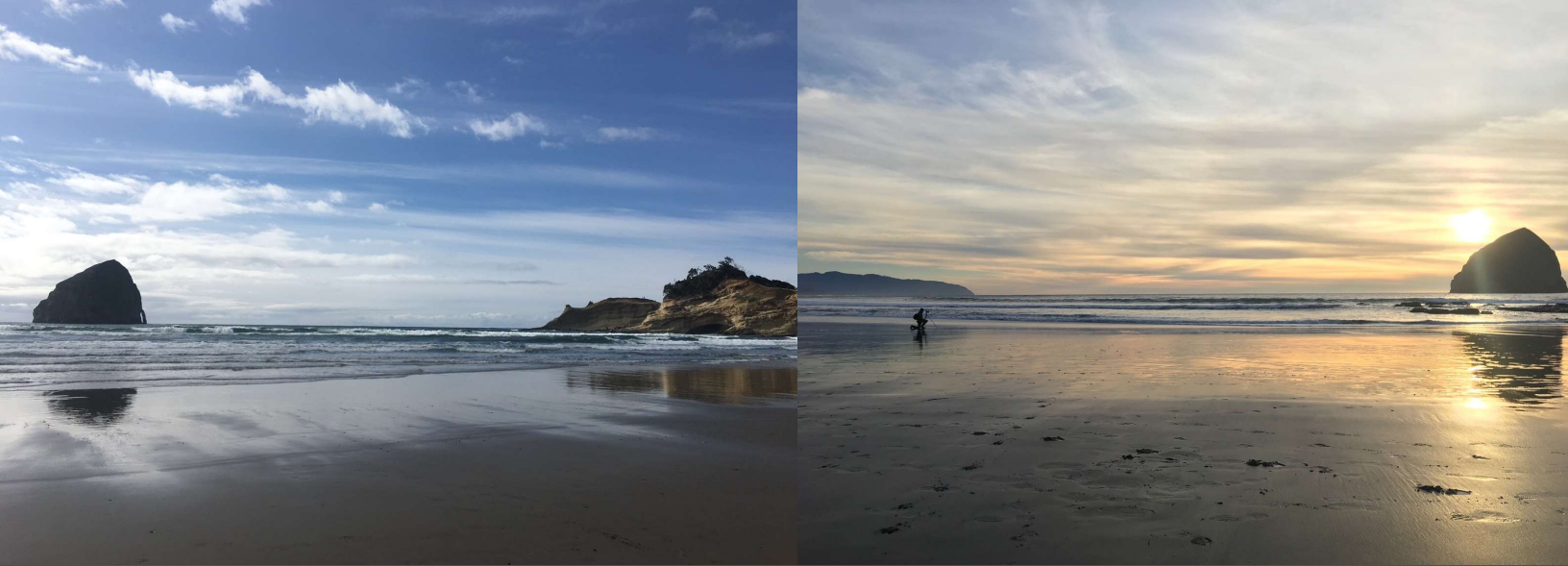

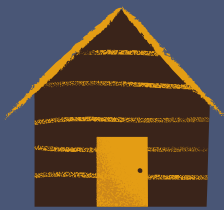

Map not to scale

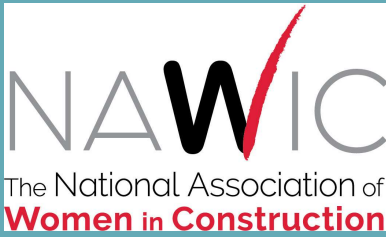
