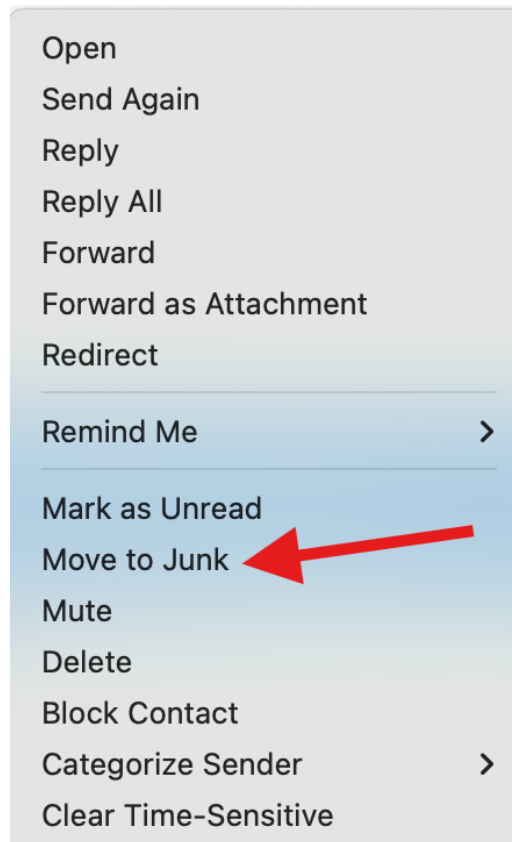




Marking an Email as Spam and Blocking a Sender in Apple Mail

On your computer, right-click the unwanted message. Select “Move to Junk”.



Click it and Apple Mail will move the message to Spam and record your report. You can report several messages at once by holding down the Command (⌘) key and clicking all the messages you want to report. Once you have them all selected, let go of the Command (⌘) key and follow the instructions above.

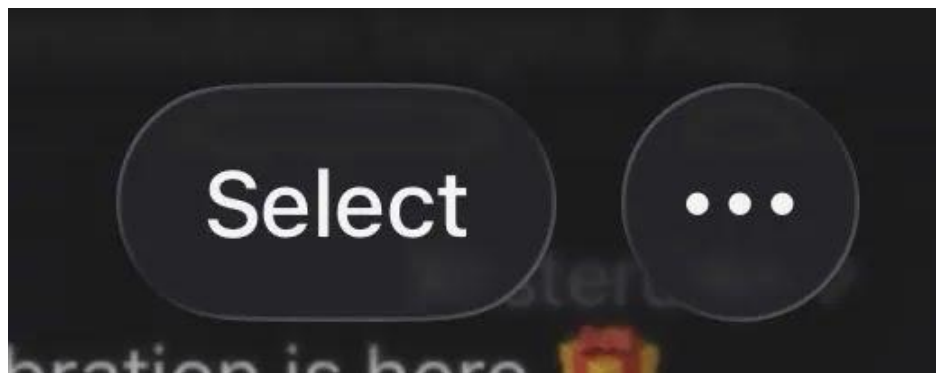

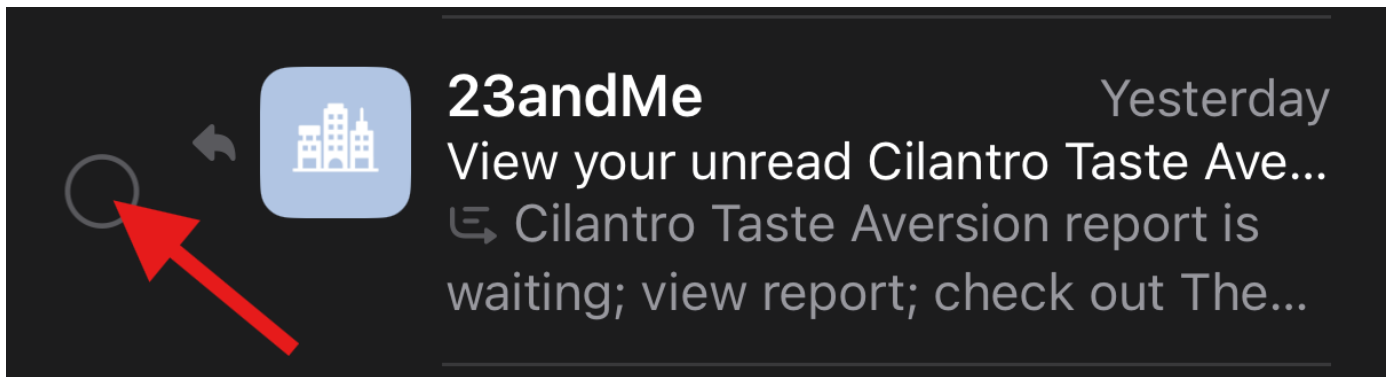

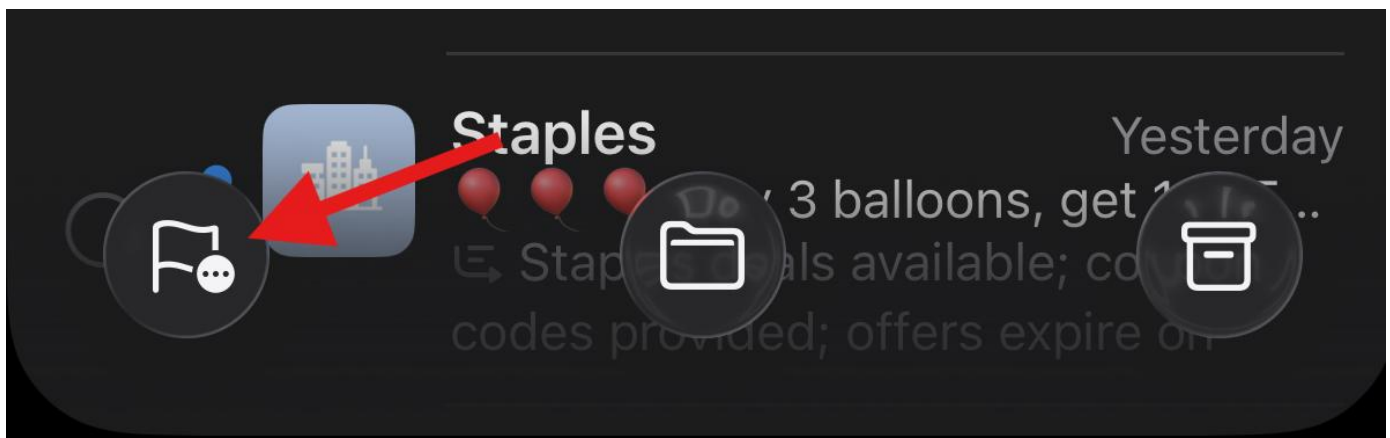
In the Apple Mail app on a phone or tablet, tap the select button in the top right corner.



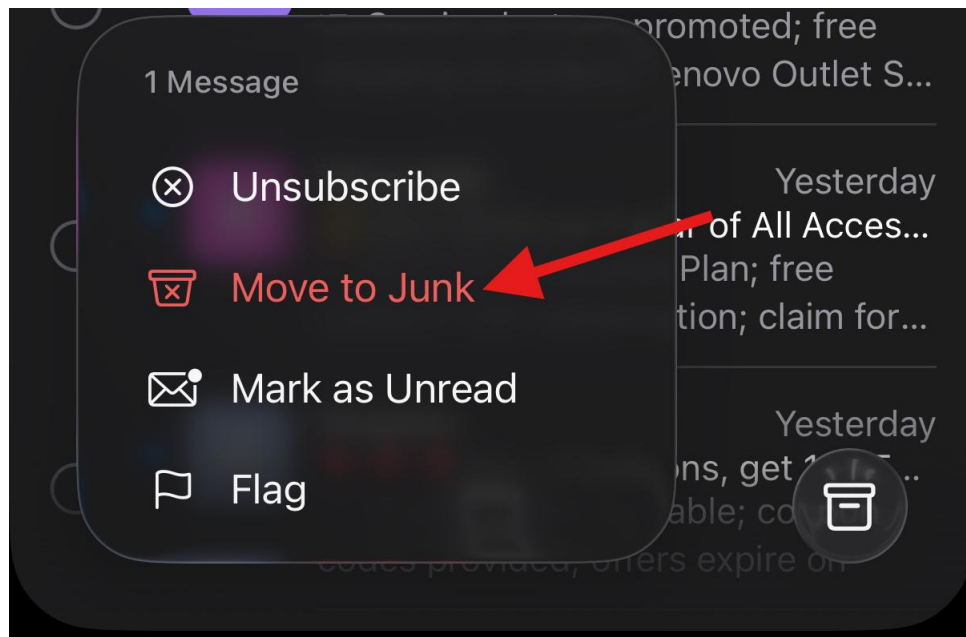
Select the message you want to report.



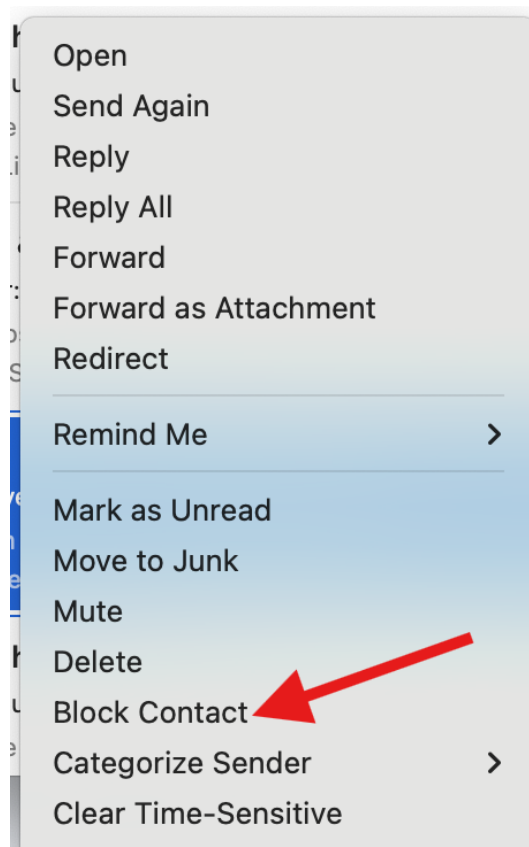
Tap the icon that looks like a flag in the bottom left corner.



Tap “Move to Junk”.



If you don’t want anything else from that address, you can block the sender. On a computer, right-click the message and select “Block Contact”.





In the Apple Mail app on a phone or tablet, press and hold the message you want to block the sender of until a menu appears. In that menu, select “Block Contact”.
