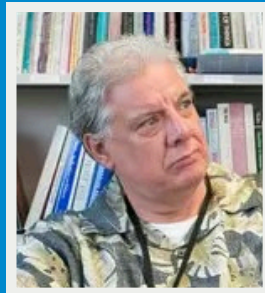

# SCHEDULE

## MARCH 7TH - MARCH 21ST

March 7: Fly to Turkey

March 8: Arrive at Izmir airport and depart for Kusadasi for dinner and overnight stay.

March 9: Head to Ephesus to visit the Terrace Houses, Great Theatre, Fountain of Trajan, Library of Celsus, Chapel of the Virgin Mary, and Basilica of St. John. Then on to Miletus (one of Paul's stops on his Third Missionary Journey) and Didyma. Dinner and overnight in Kusadasi.

March 10: Take a charter boat to the island of Patmos and tour the Monastery of St. John and the Grotto of the Revelation. Dinner and overnight in Kusadasi.

March 11: Visit the ancient cities of Hierapolis (Necropolis, Domitian Gate, Byzantine Gate, Roman Bath) and Laodicea (Zeus Temple, Monumental Fountain, Odeon, Imperial Cult, Caracalla Fountain). Dinner and overnight in Kusadasi.

March 12: Depart to Canakkale, with stops in Pergamum (Acropolis, Great Theater, Red Basilica) and the ancient city of Troy. Dinner and overnight in Canakkale.

March 13: Cross the Greek border and tour the ancient colony of Philippi (ancient theatre, Church of Philippi, Baptistery of St. Lydia of Filippisias). Dinner and overnight in the beautiful city of Kavala in Greece.

March 14: Depart for the ancient Greek city of Amphipolis, and then on to Thessaloniki, the second largest city in Greece, for a city tour, dinner and overnight stay.

March 15: Tours of Vergina and Veria, built at the foot of Mount Vermio. Dinner and overnight in Kalambaka.

March 16: Tours of Meteora, Itsea and Thermopylae. Dinner and overnight in Delphi.

March 17: Tour of Delphi, then head to the coastal town of Nafpaktos. Dinner and overnight in ancient Olympia.

March 18: Tour of Olympia, the venue of the Olympic Games. Dinner and overnight stay in Nafplion, one of the most scenic cities in the country.

March 19: Head to ancient Corinth, then on to Cenchræe and the Isthmus of Corinth. Dinner and overnight in Athens.

March 20: All day tour of Athens (Kallimarmaro, Zappeion Hall, Greek Parliament, Mars Hill, Acropolis, Parthenon Monument). Dinner and overnight in Athens.

March 21: Fly home from Athens.
