Ullery Receives National Athletic Trainer's Association Award

Larry Robert "Rob" Ullery, GHS 1987, M.S., Certified Athletic Trainer ATC, has been selected as one of the National Athletic Trainers' Association's 2016 Athletic Trainer Service Award recipients. Rob is a resident of Lexington, KY, and is the Director of Outreach at the University of Kentucky. This is part of the U.K. Hospital and Rob develops contracts with local schools to get patients to the Hospital to see one of their 16 Athletic Trainers. Ullery has worked on several projects to encourage community outreach and engagement with sports medicine. Working as an athletic trainer allowed Rob to mesh his two passions, nursing and athletics. Inspired by his mother **Penny Ullery**, a nurse, Ullery looked to enter a field that would allow him to help others heal.

Rob credits **Tracy Tryon**, GHS 1977, with being his mentor at GHS. His first exposure to athletic training was as a student athletic trainer for the Green Wave football and basketball teams during his sophomore year, 1984-85. **Dr. David Cox**, GHS 1959, and **Dr. David Trimble**, GHS 1972, first supported Rob and encouraged him to attend an athletic training camp at St. Elizabeth's Hospital in Dayton. Later he graduated from Ohio Northern University in 1991, and earned a Master's degree from Ohio University. He has been at UK for 20 years and serves as president of the Kentucky Athletic Trainers Society.

The Jennings Center Track and Field Complex

The new **Jennings Center Track and Field Complex** had its Dedication Wednesday, April 11, 2018, with the Jennings family cutting the ribbon. **Brad Jennings**, GHS 1994, and his family, **Alex, Madeline, Gavin, Steve Jennings**, GHS 1990, **Beth, Emma,** GHS 2018, **Christian,** and **Collin** participated in the ceremony in front of a large crowd of government dignitaries, business leaders, Friends of Harmon Field committee members, donors to the Friends of Harmon Field, fans, and Greenville City Schools employees and coaches. Brad anchored this project with an \$800,000 donation to make this stadium become a reality.

GHS alums **Jon McGreevey**, GHS 1996, and **Matt Light**, GHS 1996, had the vision over three years ago to improve the athletic facilities used by the Green Wave. The first two phases are complete: synthetic turf on the current football stadium Harmon Field, and an 8-lane track in the separate stadium built to the north, with bleachers, lighting and track and field turf. The second half of the project is yet to be funded and includes an athletic complex located between both facilities with locker rooms, concession, and restrooms, along with new bleachers for the football stadium and new lights. The remainder to be done will cost about \$2,200,000. It's not too late to become involved in this GHS history. Go to friendsofharmonfield.com to check for updates and ways to donate.

"What a great day," said McGreevey. "We have the Jennings family, a lot of community support and a lot of community members that donated a lot of time and money to make this happen. It's a great day for the City of Greenville, the students and community overall."

"The Jennings Center is an incredible example of how a private and public partnership is supposed to work," Matt Light stated. "The Jennings family generosity was the catalyst of what will be a completely new and exciting era in GHS sports history. I'm extremely proud of the Friends of Harmon Field Committee and all the Greenville School Board members for their commitment on this project."

Track season 2019 update:

The Dwight Salzman Relays was one of the most prestigious track events in the Miami Valley many years ago. Its importance has diminished through the years. One reason for this decline was that the Greenville Harmon Field track was too small and inadequate for today's track event demands, so the only school teams that would come to compete were Junior High teams. With the 2018 completion of the Jennings Center Track and Field Complex, the Salzman Relays varsity track event has finally made its return April 19, 2019. Four schools participated—Greenville, Piqua, Sidney, Dixie, and the Greenville B team. The Green Wave boys won easily, and the Lady Wave girls finished a close second to Piqua. **Bill Plessinger** GHS 1980 is the Head Greenville Track and Field Coach.
