

Child Safety Standards

Last Updated: 2025

1. Protection of Children's Personal Data

- We do not collect personal information from children under the age of 13 (or the minimum age required by local law) without verifiable parental or legal guardian consent.
- Any information provided by minors is handled with strict confidentiality and enhanced security measures.
- We do not sell, trade, or share children's data with third parties for commercial purposes.

2. Appropriate and Responsible Content

- All content on our website is suitable for general audiences and does not include violent, sexual, discriminatory, or harmful material.
- If any content may not be suitable for minors, we will clearly display a warning before access.
- We promptly remove any content that violates the integrity or rights of children and adolescents.

3. Safe Interactions (Chats, Comments, Community Spaces)

- We monitor and moderate public interactions to prevent inappropriate behavior toward minors.
- We do not allow bullying, harassment, inappropriate contact attempts, or requests for personal information from minors.
- Any suspicious behavior is reported, blocked, and escalated when necessary.

4. Parental Controls and Transparency

- We inform parents or guardians about how data is collected, used, and stored.
- Parents or guardians may request access to their child's data or request its deletion at any time.
- We provide transparent explanations of our practices in accordance with applicable laws.

5. Reporting and Incident Response

- We provide accessible channels for reporting any content or interaction that may pose a risk to minors.
- Reports involving child safety are prioritized to ensure prompt action.

- We cooperate with law enforcement when a situation involves potential harm to a child.

6. Staff Training and Compliance

- Our team receives ongoing training in child protection and online safety.
- Our policies are aligned with COPPA, GDPR-K, and the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child.

7. Continuous Improvement

We regularly review and update our child safety standards to ensure alignment with evolving regulations and global best practices.
