It is our goal that our TK students leave our program with social and emotional confidence and be better prepared academically to begin their school years.  - STEM & Skill Building Program in the afternoon (sewing, wood-working, music appreciation, simple machines, botany etc)
 - Artist of the month (Art show to showcase their art and the end of the school year)
 - Phonics, writing and language development through the *Heggerty Curriculum* and *FUNdations* curriculum.
 - Development of self-help skills and encourage development of positive self-esteem
 - Science (Earth and environment, physical science, and live science)
 - Common Core Mathematics
