#### **PRESIDENT'S CORNER**

A few bits of info we thought you might want to know:

- We met our Direct Donation goal and cannot thank you enough (in fact we've been so busy working on the Direct Donation, doing the water balloon toss, pizza parties, etc. that we had to combine the Oct. and Nov. newsletters). We are aware that it is December (oof) and we will send that one out by the end of the month.
- IUSD denied the charter petition for the Chinese Cultural Center for language immersion (a new petition can now go to the County along with IUSD's denial).
- CA Governor signed into law SB 328 (mandatory late start schedule for CA middle and high schools), which will go into effect for the 2021-2022 year.
- CA Teacher Association wants to remind parents that the OC Board of Education elections are in March. They are endorsing Andy Thorburn.
- IPSF reminder Irvine (through a grant) will match dollar for dollar money donated to IPSF and contributions are tax deductible. They also reported that Five Point is making a \$1 million donation to IPSF.
- Direct Donation money is being spend on kids immediately - we already donated \$500 to PBIS and ordered water bottles for the Shark Store, bought new EZ ups – hello shade! More details to follow in the next newsletter on how your money is being spent.
- Irvine police there has been a rise in the use of Xanax and Vicodin by teenagers – kids getting from parents' prescriptions; talk to kids about drugs, vaping, and guns (and lock up your medicines and guns).
