
Do the student's grades show regular improvement?

Our 1 to 1 lessons follow these steps: 1. The student and tutor jointly agree to do their best to create and follow a shared plan. This includes recognizing areas to be strengthened, setting goals, and taking responsibility for the results.

2. The tutor goes beyond just teaching specific subjects or reading books together; they establish quantifiable metrics to measure achievement (such as the number of pages read in a month, completion rate of homework, or the number of notes written by the student for introspection), which are charted and reported to the student's parents and the Bridge Director. (3) The tutor actively assists in identifying and addressing obstacles that prevent the student from making progress, contributing to the student's ongoing growth.

The above factors for measurement may vary depending on the individual.
