## THEORY AND HYPOTHESES

## Hypotheses only on household level: <br> Availability argument:

More time for paid work implies less time for care activities

- actual paid working hours,
- working overtime

Demand argument:
The more time is needed for care activities, the more time will be spent into caring tasks

- Presence of children
- Actual working hours of partner
- responsible for the domestic and caring tasks
