

A BEGINNER'S GUIDE TO JUDGING CATEGORIES & CRITERIA

The gleaming boats displayed at our show today represent five categories of Antique and Classic Boats. These categories include:

Historic:	Built before 1919
Antique:	Built between 1919 – 1942 inclusive
Classic:	Built between 1943 – 1975 inclusive
Late Classic	Built between 1976 and 25 years prior to the current year. For 2021, the Late Classic periods ends with 1995
Contemporary:	Wood boat built in the last 25 years. For 2021, the Contemporary period begins with 1996

Boats are judged according to ACBS sanctioned judging format. At the time the boat left the factory many years ago, it would have been considered a 100-point boat. Today, points are deducted from that 100-point total in the following categories for inaccuracies in restoration such as incorrect hardware, engine or upholstery color and also for the overall quality of the restoration.

20 pts	Exterior – General Appearance
20 pts	Interior & Upholstery
20 pts	Engine Compartment & Engine
20 pts	Quality of Finish
20 pts	Instruments & Hardware
100 pts	TOTAL

- There are 16 categories (see below)
- Preserved boats are those that retain at least 60% of their original deck and sides. Their bottoms can be replaced, but must be replaced using the original construction method
- Restored boats are those that retain less than 60% of their original deck and sides or are reconstructed using non-original methods
- The highest point preserved and restored boats will be awarded the “Best of Show”.
- There is also a “Best Non-Wood” award for the highest point non-wood boat.
- There is an award sponsored by ACBS International for the boat that, in the judges’ opinion, is the most original or best-preserved entry in the show.
- The highest point boat of those remaining in each category will receive the award for that category
- There are also marquee awards for entries manufactured by certain builders such as Chris Craft, Gar Wood, Century, Lyman, etc.
- No entry will receive more than one award based on judging criteria.
