- Must have a support system for handler



- · Support system can be parents, family, or paid caregiver. (Should be a permanent fixture.)
- Specialized knowledge and additional support
- Tasking can include PTSD and Mobility but also:
 - Sensory/tactile support
 - Anchoring
 - Corralling
 - Tracking/finding wandering or lost individual
 - · Leading someone home
 - Finding help
 - Custom tasks as needed
- Lifetime support

Dogs trained for these tasks have strong confidence and obedience, but still are playful pets!
