### Collegiate Peaks:

- Service dog for Individuals with:
  - Autism
  - Dementia
  - Schizophrenia
  - Some DID (Dissociative Identity Disorder)
- Mile High Service Dog package is required
- Must be purchased at the BEGINNING of training
- Must have a support system for handler

### A Mile High Service Dog + Collegiate Peaks:

- Support system can be parents, family, or paid caregiver. (Should be a permanent fixture.)
- Specialized knowledge and additional support
- Tasking can include PTSD and Mobility but also:
  - Sensory/tactile support
  - Anchoring
  - Corraling
  - Tracking/finding wandering or lost individual
  - Leading someone home
  - Finding help
  - Custom tasks as needed
- Lifetime support

Dogs trained for these tasks have strong confidence and obedience, but still are playful pets!

#### What is "Differential Bonding"?

It is where the dog learns to listen to handler differently than the support system.

For instance, a dog may listen to basic obedience from the handler, but then will not allow handler into a street or track them down if they leave the home.
