Maroon Bells:

- Service Dog for limited visual or hearing impairment
- · NOT:
 - A seeing eye guide dog for an individual who is blind
 - For a fully deaf individual
- Mile High Service Dog package is required



A Mile High Service Dog + Maroon Bells:

- Visual Impairment:
 - Stops at easily identifiable obstacles, such as curbs, streets, stairs, trees/shrubs, cars, and people
 - Notice visual cues, like flashing lights or strobes
 - o Identify discrete and specific objects or individuals
 - Recognize entries and exits of frequented locations
 - o Guide around the home
 - Special equipment may be required
- Hearing Impairment:
 - o Block cars, bikes, or other vehicles
 - o Waking up for alarms, warnings, etc.
 - o Alert to when people or other objects approach from behind
 - o Can learn simple sign language
- o Lead or follow in a crowd or on a walk/hike
- Other custom tasks as needed
- Lifetime support
- Up to 5 in home lessons until completion of requested tasks
