Reminder on Weather Policy

As a reminder, our policy for cancelling group classes or outdoor appointments is as follows:

We will do everything in our power to hold classes and training regardless of temperature unless it would be unsafe to do so for our staff, clients, or the dogs we train. Safety is always a priority! We would cancel outdoor training sessions (heel) and outdoor based group classes if:

- it is colder than 20 degrees outside at the time of the event;
- Or there is a warning in effect by the state or weather department advising people to stay inside and not allow their animals outside;
- Or there is such a high rate of precipitation at the time of the event that visibility and safety is of a concern.
- If the temperature is expected to be 90 or above, we assess conditions. We will usually, but not always hold class when it is 90-100 degrees depending on a number of factors (cloud cover, sunshine, ground temperature), but class may be shortened. If it is expected to be over 100 degrees, we will generally cancel class.

We will cancel all events for the day if:

- There is an advisory from the state, city, or county encouraging people to stay off the roads and not leave their homes for safety;
- And/or there are massive road closures due to a storm, weather, or construction conditions that inhibit trainers/clients from being able to reach their appointments/class in a safe manner.

Outside of these conditions, we do plan to hold all events, classes, and trainings as much as we possibly can so we're able to continue to serve our clients year round. Management does reserve the right to reschedule or cancel trainings and events as the need arises and do our best to communicate this as soon as we possibly can. The announcement is made via email and social media.



R2S (Rescue 2 Service) Dogs!

How to Sign Up For Group Classes

To sign up for a group class:

1. Go to or create your Paw Partner account on the [Paw Partner App](#).
2. Tap on "Make Reservation."
3. Tap on "Training."
4. Select your pet's name.
5. You will find group classes at the bottom of the "Select Service" drop-down menu. Just select the Group Class you want. You will be presented with a list of available dates for that specific group class. Find the group class date you are interested in and tap on "Select This Training Course."
6. If you are signing up multiple dogs, you will have to sign up each dog individually.
7. If you wish to remove your dog from a given group class, simply click on the trash can icon next to the word "Joined."
8. Please do not schedule more than two weeks out.
9. **DO NOT WAIT FOR CONFIRMATION**; If you sign up and receive a "pending" response, go ahead and plan to attend!

Group Class Requirements



- Bring a leash so we can be in accordance with all local leash laws. Make it a standard 6 foot leash and NOT a retractable.
- You must have a flat collar on your dog (standard one that goes around the neck).
- You must have an e-collar on your dog that is charged and ready to go. You must have the transmitter with you.
- Your dog must have had all three rounds of shots and be current on rabies (or proof of equivalent titers) to participate.
- We may ask you not to participate if these requirements are not met.


