How to Sign Up For Group Classes

To sign up for a group class:

- 1.Go to or create your Paw Partner account on the Paw Partner App.
- 2. Tap on "Make Reservation."
- 3. Tap on "Training."
- 4. Select your pet's name.
- 5. You will find group classes at the bottom of the "Select Service" drop-down menu. Just select the Group Class you want. You will be presented with a list of available dates for that specific group class. Find the group class date you are interested in and tap on "Select This Training Course."
- 6.If you are signing up multiple dogs, you will have to sign up each dog individually.
- 7.If you wish to remove your dog from a given group class, simply click on the trash can icon next to the word "Joined."
- 8. Please do not schedule more than two weeks out.
- 9.DO NOT WAIT FOR CONFIRMATION; If you sign up and receive a "pending" response, go ahead and plan to attend!


Group Class Requirements





