- Service Dog North now at Flatirons Mall: Effective Wednesday, June 11th, we are moving the location of the Service Dog Class North Location. It is now at Flatirons Mall, meeting on the north side of Dick's Sporting Goods, 31 W Flatiron Crossing Dr, Broomfield, CO 80021. (Colorado Mills did not have escalators we discovered.) This will be updated on the calendar.
- Boulder Friday night on Hiatus: Due to low attendance as well as staff changes, we are putting the Boulder Obedience Group Class on Friday night for the time being. We apologize for any inconvenience. Please consider attending the Tuesday night group class at Cabela's. We are working on getting new staff trained to open up this class.
- Sunday Protection Class is at 4 pm at Utah Park

Denver Area:

- *Tuesdays*, Obedience Group Class with public access, 6 pm, Cabela's in Thornton: 14050 Lincoln St, Thornton, CO, 80023. Meet on the north lawn.
- Wednesdays, Service Dog Group Class, 6 pm. Alternating locations. All clients are welcome, but the emphasis is on service dog public access training and certification preparation.
 - On 5/21, Park Meadows Mall, Dillard's: 8415 Park Meadows Center Dr, Lone Tree, CO 80124, USA. Meet outside Dillard's along the northeast face outside, kind of directly east of the Chester St. and Westview Rd intersection. Subsequent dates: 6/4, 6/18, 7/2. 7/16, etc.
 - On 5/28, we will be having Movie Night for Service Dogs at Sloan's Lake Alamo Drafthouse.  Meet outside Dick's entrance near the southwest side of the mall. Subsequent dates: 6/11, 7/9, 7/23, etc.

- Thursdays, Therapy Dog Group Class, 6 pm Wash Park, 1000 S. Downing St, Denver, CO, 80210. All clients are welcome, but the emphasis is on therapy dog work and preparation for therapy dog certification.
 - Located near the intersection of Tennessee and S. Downing on the west side of Wash Park. Parking
 will be on nearby streets as well as some in the center of the park near the playground, but all
 parking is free. The class is north of the basketball court on the lawn. Take the small footbridge near

the intersection of Tennessee and Downing and cross the creek into the park. Once you get across the creek, if you look slightly to your left you will see some tennis and basketball courts. We hold classes in the grass just to the north of the basketball courts.

- Fridays, Reactive/Aggressive Dog Group Class, 6 pm While all clients may attend, the emphasis is on behavioral modification for dogs with reactivity and/or aggressive histories.
 - Utah Park, 1800 S Peoria St, Aurora, CO, 80012. Meet on the south lawn; park on the south side of the parking lot.
- Saturdays, Obedience Group Class, 9 am Wash Park. Downing St, Denver, CO, 80210. All clients are welcome.
 - Located near the intersection of Tennessee and S. Downing on the west side of Wash Park. Parking
 will be on nearby streets as well as some in the center of the park near the playground, but all
 parking is free. The class is north of the basketball court on the lawn. Take the small footbridge near
 the intersection of Tennessee and Downing and cross the creek into the park. Once you get across
 the creek, if you look slightly to your left you will see some tennis and basketball courts. We hold
 classes in the grass just to the north of the basketball courts.
- Sundays, Protection & Obedience Class Sunday, 4 pm Protection Group Class with Obedience in between protection drills. It is a good opportunity for dogs who need help with dog distractions. Must be in a protection program to participate in protection activities.

- Wednesdays, Obedience Group Class, 6 pm Bass Pro Shops, 13012 Bass Pro Dr, Colorado Springs, CO 80921. Meet in their entry foyer by the fireplaces before beginning class. There is a hard cap of 10 dogs, so if you are late you may be turned away. We are working on a reservation system.
- Thursdays, Service Dog Group Class, 6 pm:
 - This class will include a lot of work on elevators, escalators, control on stairways, and tasking in a public setting, and manners in a public setting.
 - Alternates between Scheels and Chapel Hills Mall:
 - Chapel Hills Mall, 1710 Briargate Blvd, Colorado Springs, CO, 80920. Meet at the entrance next to the escalators at the food court. Dates: 5/22, 6/5, 6/19, 7/3, 7/17, 7/31, etc.
 - Scheels, 1226 Interquest Parkway, Colorado Springs, CO, 80921. Meet at the front entrance either outside or in the lobby area, depending on weather and traffic. Dates: 5/28, 6/12, 6/26, 7/10, 7/24, etc.

 protection dogs only. This class will cater towards developing your dog's bark deterrence (Level One

- Please continue to text your request for attendance while we retrofit Paw Partner and re-set up the group class function. We apologize for the inconvenience.
- Bring a leash so we can be in accordance with all local leash laws. Make it a standard 6 foot leash and not a retractable.
- Your dog must wear a flat collar (a standard one that goes around the neck).
- Your dog must have an e-collar on your dog that is charged and ready to go. You must have the charged transmitter with you.
- Your dog must have had all three rounds of shots and be current on rabies (or proof of equivalent titers) to participate. These must be on file with Yes And Dog Training.
- We may ask you not to participate if these requirements are not met.
