This Week at Yes And Dog Training - December 3, 2025



WINTER IS HERE! COLD IS HERE! MORE SNOW IS COMING!



Here are some tips:



- **Altitude makes cold feel colder.** Dogs tire faster and lose heat more quickly at 5,000–10,000 ft. Keep outdoor time shorter on very cold days.
- **Ice-melt chemicals are everywhere.** Denver sidewalks use salts that irritate paws. Use booties when possible and wipe paws after walks.
- **Dry Colorado snow forms “snowball paws.”** Trim fur between pads and use paw balm to prevent ice clumping as dogs “sweat” through their paws in addition to panting.
- **Rapid temperature swings matter.** Colorado can drop 30° overnight—dogs don’t acclimate that fast. Add a jacket on sudden cold days. Limit potty breaks and walks to 15 minutes or less.
- **Hydration is a winter need.** Dry mountain air dehydrates dogs quickly. Offer water right after walks and play, maybe even more so in winter cold than summer heat.
- **Wind chill is a real hazard.** If the wind stings your face, shorten your dog’s outdoor time too. Use a vest to minimize wind chill, even for snow dogs.
- **Mountain outings require extra caution.** Watch for icy trails, sharp crusted snow, and sudden weather changes; use paw protection. Practice with booties for the real thing; it takes time for dogs to get used to them.

How to Sign Up For Group Classes

To sign up for a group class:

1. Go to or create your Paw Partner account on the [Paw Partner App](#).
2. Tap on "Make Reservation."
3. Tap on "Training."
4. Select your pet's name.
5. You will find group classes at the bottom of the "Select Service" drop-down menu. Just select the Group Class you want. You will be presented with a list of available dates for that specific group class. Find the group class date you are interested in and tap on "Select This Training Course."
6. If you are signing up multiple dogs, you will have to sign up each dog individually.
7. If you wish to remove your dog from a given group class, simply click on the trash can icon next to the word "Joined."
8. Please do not schedule more than two weeks out.
9. DO NOT WAIT FOR CONFIRMATION; if you sign up and receive a "pending" response, go ahead and plan to attend!

Group Class Requirements



- Bring a leash so we can be in accordance with all local leash laws. Make it a standard 6 foot leash and NOT a retractable.
- You must have a flat collar on your dog (standard one that goes around the neck).
- You must have an e-collar on your dog that is charged and ready to go. You must have the transmitter with you.
- Your dog must have had all three rounds of shots and be current on rabies (or proof of equivalent titers) to participate.
- We may ask you not to participate if these requirements are not met.
