With 4th of July this Friday, we thought we'd give a few tips on fireworks. And after that, are reminders of what's happening this week!

Fireworks are hard for dogs. And it is hard for us to properly socialize our four-legged friends to them because for most of us, fireworks happen twice a year (4th of July and New Year's Eve). Some of us might be lucky enough to live near Coors Field where they shoot them off more often, but it is still a challenge.

From Yes And Dog Training, here are some tips!

- Play a video of fireworks starting with average volume. Praise your dog, play with them, train, just make it an overall fun experience! And then slowly increase the volume. You can do this in a short amount of time, with short intervals that increase.
- Try a Happy Hoodie- basically a tube sock that goes over a dogs head- is more effective than a weighted jacket as it is the noise and the vibrations that the dog struggles with and something over their body will not work, it has to be over their ears. Here is a link to the Happy Hoodie and on Amazon.
  - For those with more sensitive ears, you might up your game with Dog Earmuffs for hearing protection. When we did the CSU football games they would shoot off a cannon and these helped our dogs.
- When fireworks are happening, play a movie they like and spend time with your dog to distract them with more noises than just fireworks.
- You can also help make them a cave in your closet to give them a safe space to retreat to.
