CANCELLATIONS & UPCOMING SCHEDULING MODIFICATIONS

- **MODIFICATIONS TO THE COLORADO SPRINGS GROUP CLASS SCHEDULE:**
 - We are making some changes to the Colorado Springs Group Class schedule.
 - Wednesday night Obedience Dog Group Class will no longer be held.
 - Thursday night Service Class will now alternate between Obedience and Service.
 - Thursday, 9/4, will be Service Dog class at Scheel's.
 - Thursday, 9/11 will be Obedience Dog class at Bass Pro.
 - Service Dog classes at Scheel's: 9/4, 9/18, 10/2, 10/16, 10/30, 11/13, 11/27, etc.
 - Obedience Dog classes at Bass Pro: 9/11, 9/25, 10/9, 10/23, 11/6, 11/20, etc.
