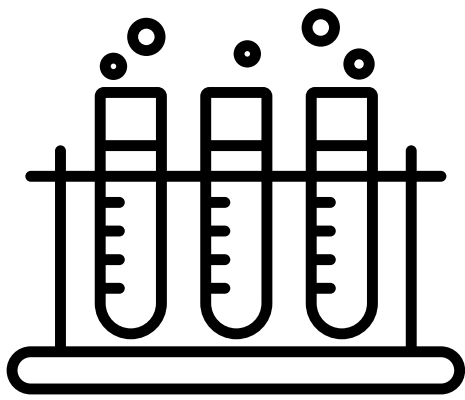
THE HOW

1. ASK

The first step is about listening carefully. We work with you to understand:



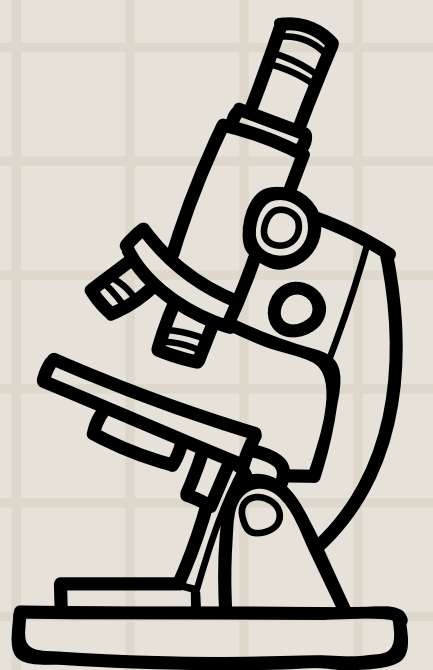
- Your broad goals

This high-level understanding sets the stage for a program that is **relevant, realistic, and strategically aligned**.

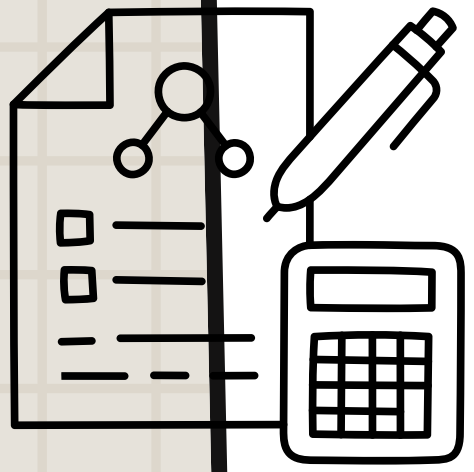
2. ENGAGE

3. DESIGN



Armed with insights from the needs analysis, we move into a collaborative design phase:
