






## COVID-19: Prep for your pet Who will care for your pet?



While it's not fun to imagine, now is an important time to create a plan for your pet in case you get sick. We strongly encourage you gather any members of your household and walk through the following steps to ensure your animals will be cared for in the event of an emergency:







- Name and contact information for the person who can care for your pets
- Name and contact information for your back-up in case your go-to is no longer able to help
- . Food, treats, a leash, a couple of toys, and any other supplies necessary to care for your pet for at least two weeks
- A crate or carrier to transport your pet
- Vaccination records
- Collars with ID tags (don't forget to update your pet's microchip information)
- Medications and prescriptions, along with a list of instructions
- Daily care instructions
- Contact information for your veterinary clinic

With your whole family on board and a plan in place, you'll feel a bit better about your pet's safety knowing they're in good hands no matter what challenges may arise.
