(RESCUE BREATH)
- C. CIRCULATION
(CHEST COMPRESSIONS)

OPEN DOG'S MOUTH, PULL THE TONGUE STRAIGHTEN NECK AND LOCATE THE OBJECT

PUT AN HAND IN DOG'S MOUTH AND PULL OUT THE OBJECT THAT IS BLOCKING THE AIRWAY

AFTER CLEANING AIRWAYS IF THE DOG IS UNCONSCIOUS COVER HIS NOSE WITH YOUR MOUTH AND BLOW IN KEEPING HIS MOUTH SHUT

IF THE OBJECT CAN'T BE DISLODGED APPLY PRESSURE ON THE ABDOMEN BEHIND THE RIB CAGE

PICK THE DOG BY HIS THIGHS AND GENTLY SHAKE HIM

GIVE 5 SHARP BLOWS WITH YOUR HANDS ON THE DOG'S BACK BETWEEN SHOULDER BLADES



HEIMLICH MANEUVER

PERFORM CPR ONLY WHEN AIRWAYS ARE CLEAN

LAY THE DOG ON A SIDE AND LOCATE HEART BEHIND HIS ELBOW ON THE CHEST

ALTERNATE 3-5 COMPRESSIONS/ 1 BREATHE
