

Dog Clothing Size Chart

| Size | Neck (in / cm) | Chest/Girth (in / cm) | Back Length (in / cm) | Typical Breed Examples |
|--------------|---------------------|-----------------------|-----------------------|---------------------------------|
| XXS / Teacup | 6–8 in / 15–20 cm | 10–12 in / 25–30 cm | 6–8 in / 15–20 cm | Teacup Chihuahua, Teacup Yorkie |
| XS | 8–10 in / 20–25 cm | 12–16 in / 30–40 cm | 8–10 in / 20–25 cm | Chihuahua, Maltese, Yorkie |
| S | 10–12 in / 25–30 cm | 16–20 in / 40–50 cm | 10–12 in / 25–30 cm | Pomeranian, Shih Tzu, Papillon |
| M | 12–14 in / 30–35 cm | 20–24 in / 50–60 cm | 12–16 in / 30–40 cm | Cocker Spaniel, French Bulldog |
| L | 14–18 in / 35–45 cm | 24–28 in / 60–70 cm | 16–20 in / 40–50 cm | Beagle, Bulldog, Terrier mix |
| XL | 18–22 in / 45–55 cm | 28–32 in / 70–80 cm | 20–24 in / 50–60 cm | Labrador, Golden Retriever |
| XXL | 22–26 in / 55–65 cm | 32–36 in / 80–90 cm | 24–28 in / 60–70 cm | German Shepherd, Rottweiler |
| XXXL / Giant | 26–30 in / 65–75 cm | 36–44 in / 90–110 cm | 28–34 in / 70–85 cm | Great Dane, Saint Bernard |

Measuring Tips for Dogs:

- **Neck:** Around the base, add 1–2 in for comfort.
- **Chest/Girth:** Widest part behind front legs.
- **Back Length:** From base of neck to base of tail.

Cat Clothing Size Chart

| Size | Neck (in / cm) | Chest/Girth (in / cm) | Back Length (in / cm) | Typical Breed Examples |
|------------------|---------------------|-----------------------|-----------------------|----------------------------------|
| XS / Kitten | 6–7 in / 15–18 cm | 9–10 in / 23–25 cm | 6–7 in / 15–18 cm | Kittens |
| S / Small | 7–9 in / 18–23 cm | 10–13 in / 25–33 cm | 7–9 in / 18–23 cm | Average adult cats |
| M / Medium | 9–10 in / 23–25 cm | 13–15 in / 33–38 cm | 9–10 in / 23–25 cm | Larger adult cats |
| L / Large | 10–12 in / 25–30 cm | 15–17 in / 38–43 cm | 10–12 in / 25–30 cm | Maine Coon, Norwegian Forest Cat |
| XL / Extra Large | 12–14 in / 30–35 cm | 17–20 in / 43–50 cm | 12–14 in / 30–35 cm | Very large domestic cats |

Measuring Tips for Cats:

- Measure snugly but don't squeeze.
- Cats are flexible; measure while relaxed or using a helper.

Key Notes for All Pet Clothing

1. **Allowance:** Add 1–2 in / 2–5 cm for comfort.
2. **Stretch Fabrics:** For soft, stretchy clothing, sizing can be slightly smaller.
3. **Breed Considerations:** Stocky or long-haired breeds may need extra chest/back room.
4. **Accessories:** Neck size is critical for collars, harnesses, and hooded outfits.
