<p><b>Description:</b> Students demonstrate a basic understanding of text structure at the foundational level.</p> <p><b><u>The student at this level can...</u></b></p> <p><b>Identify Text Structure:</b> Students can <b>recognize some but not all</b> common text structures such as comparison, cause and effect, problem and solution, sequence, and description.</p> <p><b>Recognize Signaling Words:</b> Students recognize and defend some (but not all) signaling words or phrases that indicate specific text structures.</p> <p><b>Generate Gist:</b> Students are inconsistent when generating a main idea scaffolded by the text structure, aiding comprehension and recall.</p>	<p><b>Description:</b> Students exhibit a <b>solid</b> grasp of text structure analysis at the proficient level.</p> <p><b><u>The student at this level can...</u></b></p> <p><b>Identify all Text Structures:</b> Students can <b>recognize all</b> common text structures such as comparison, cause and effect, problem and solution, sequence, and description.</p> <p><b>Recognize Signaling Words:</b> Students recognize and defend signaling words or phrases that indicate specific text structures.</p> <p><b>Generate Gist:</b> Students can generate a main idea scaffolded by the text structure, aiding comprehension and recall.</p>	<p><b>Description:</b> At the advanced level, students <b>master</b> analyzing text structure.</p> <p><b><u>The student at this level can...</u></b></p> <p><b>...demonstrate all elements of Proficient plus:</b></p> <p><b>Conduct sophisticated Analysis:</b> Students can critically evaluate the impact of each major section on the overall text.</p> <p><b>Synthesize Information:</b> Students synthesize information across different text structures to deepen their understanding.</p> <p><b>Apply Across Genres:</b> Students can apply their knowledge of text structures across various genres (e.g., expository, narrative).</p> <p><b>Strategic Use of Text Signals:</b> Students effectively use text signals to navigate and comprehend complex texts.</p>
