General objective	Build a multifunctional complex that provides temporary shelter for migrants who arrive in Florida and surrounding areas, where humane treatment and the provision of basic and complementary services for them are privileged.
Specific objective	<p>Justify the need for its construction and operation based on the condition analysis that began to be presented at the beginning of this.</p> <p>To raise the need for the creation of the "migrant Florida s House", as a multifunctional project that allows to address the greatest number of conditions experienced by migrants according to the information and studies carried out for this purpose.</p> <p>To create a space where temporary housing, legal, medical, psychological, cultural, training, adaptation and security support is provided to the migrant, while they regularize their situation and are incorporated into American society.</p> <p>Justify its implementation, based on real needs and in accordance with the conditions and suggestions of the different commissions, organizations and bodies specialized in the subject</p> <p>To turn the "Southeast Migrant Complex" into a model of action to extend the proposal to other states and areas where it may also be required.</p> <p>Present the feasibility of its realization and the expected impact once built and operating in the calculated and programmed area of influence.</p>

Context and justification	The multifactorial conditions of the migratory phenomenon define it as a set of interrelated stages and attention to different social, economic and political levels without prejudice to the variants of governmental and international action.
Means of implementation	Considering the statistics and the growth trend of foreign migration in USA, the project is designed to provide annual shelter to 3600 people and attention to a floating population of up to 5000 people per year. This would make it possible to provide effective counseling and complementary care to 60% of the migrants expected in Florida by 2027, the year in which the housing development of the "Florida s Migrant Complex" is expected to be completed, following the trend of growth of the migrant population in the state.
