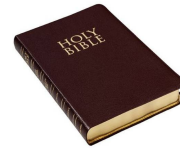

2 Tim 3:16-17

All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, 17 that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.

Here is God's Plan of Salvation: Just the Facts

- 1) **Hear** the gospel, By Hearing God's Word our Faith grows (Rom. 10:17; John 20:30,31). We are saved by faith and grace (Eph 2:8)
 - 2) **Believe** in the deity of Christ (John 8:24; John 3:18).
By believing we accept Christ as God's Son and Our Saviour
 - 3) **Repent** of sins (Luke 13:5; Acts 17:30).
Repentance is a change of thinking that leads us to change the Way we live!
 - 4) **Confess faith** in Christ (Rom. 10:9,10; Acts 8:36-38).
Publicly confess Christ to be the Son of God.
 - 5) **Be baptized** in water for the remission of sins (Mark 16:16; Acts 2:38; 22:16; Rom. 6:3,4; Gal. 3:26,27; 1 Pet. 3:21).
 - 6) **Continue in the faith**, living for the Lord; for, if not, salvation Can be lost (Heb. 10:36-39; Rev. 2:10; 2 Pet. 2:20-22).
