James 4:13–17

Come now, you who say, “**Today** or tomorrow we will go to such and such a city, spend a year there, buy and sell, and make a profit”; ¹⁴ **whereas you do not know what *will happen tomorrow***. For what *is* your life? It is even a vapor that appears for a little time and then vanishes away. ¹⁵ Instead you *ought* to say, “If the Lord wills, we shall live and do this or that.” ¹⁶ But now you boast in your arrogance. All such boasting is evil.

¹⁷ Therefore, to him who knows to do good and does not do *it*, to him it is sin.

2 Cor 6:1–2

We then, *as* workers together *with Him* also plead with *you* not to receive the grace of God in vain. ² For He says:

*“In an acceptable time I have heard you,
And in the day of salvation I have helped
you.”*
