Triple J Freight Hauler Policy:

As a hauler, I attest all drivers employed will follow the Triple J Tie & Timber, LLC Driver Policy:

1. Please review info at www.triplejtimber.com/directions
2. Hard Hats, Safety glasses, High Visibility Vests, Long Pants, and Steel Toes Shoes should be worn at all times.
3. Drivers will yield to other operating equipment and pedestrians.
4. Stay in cab during unloading – or be 25 to 50 ft from truck and in clear sight of loader operator. Do not wander around yard. Stay in the unloading zone.
5. Only Triple J Tie & Timber, LLC employees are authorized to operate Triple J Tie & Timber, LLC equipment.
6. Clean/Sweep off your truck/trailer ONLY in the unloading zone. Do not litter our yard.
7. No smoking or drinking on Triple J Tie & Timber, LLC properties.
8. Passengers are not allowed to exit truck on yard except in case of emergency.
9. All drivers must exit the truck and enter scale house inbound and outbound.
10. It is the driver's responsibility to review data on final ticket for correctness. The hauler will be held liable for damages due to incorrect data provided.
11. If your equipment is damaged during the unload process, notify the scale house and complete the damage assessment form BEFORE LEAVING OUR FACILITY.
12. By entering our yard, you personally agree to consent to a drug and alcohol test if you are involved in an incident while on our yard.
13. If you see something unsafe on our yard, say something. Contact the scale house at 662-547-6600.
14. In the event of an emergency, dial 911.

Hauler agrees to maintain insurance coverage and provide certificate of insurance to Triple J Tie & Timber, LLC prior to commencement of any work. Minimum coverage of

- A. Workers Compensation: Statutory Limits. Employers Liability: \$100K/\$500K/\$100K
