The Carmel Pointe board met on August 12th via Zoom. We review the bids from three companies for our annual gate maintenance contract. After reviewing the bids, we chose Moving Gate Systems to replace Kaiser Gate Company. Moving Gate has extensive experience with our equipment, and their terms of service and costs were more favorable. We also voted to replace our NO TRESPASSING signs with new ones that have legally correct language.

I will be retiring from the board at the January annual meeting after serving 10 years on the board and we will be taking applications for anyone who would like to run for the board. On Thursday we had a man ring our doorbell who said he was canvasing for signatures for the AFLCIO. I informed him immediately that he was trespassing and that we had signs posted and that we were a gated community that did not allow this. He rather forcefully insisted that he had every right to be in our community, invoking free speech, and I could do nothing to stop him. I told him again that he was trespassing and that he needed to leave our community immediately. He refused and said he was going to continue canvasing the neighborhood. I told him I was going to call the police if he did not leave, and he replied "Go Ahead" so I did. He then went to the east end of Bridalveil and stood there. The Oro Valley police responded quickly and after a few minutes they followed him as he walked to the west end of Bridalveil and left our community via the pedestrian/cart path. The officer who responded called me soon after and reported that a van was dropping these people off in neighborhoods in our area and that he was sure he would be receiving more calls before the day was over. At 7:00 pm as Jan and I were on our patio we saw him walking east on the sidewalk along the road to the community center and stop and sat down at the corner right behind our house. A few minutes later an OV police car stopped and went over to talk to him again.

I want to encourage residents who encounter anyone canvasing or trespassing in our community to call the OV police department at 520-229-4900 and tell them what is going on so they can respond accordingly. The woman who answered my call and put me through immediately to the person who sent out the officer.

I mentioned in July that the Mexican Bird of Paradise plants were really doing well and they are still looking very good! The photo to the right displays just a couple of these plants.

Monsoon season is still with us and as we near the end of August, we are still seeing a few decent storms, but so far, no more damage... fingers crossed! As summer winds down, we also begin to decrease irrigation as the very hot days are behind us. We irrigate year round but the winter months are when we use the least water.



Again, a reminder to please **not hand water** the plants, shrubs and trees that are on the Carmel Pointe irrigation system. If you have concerns about any plants, please let us know by calling the answering service as noted in the next paragraph.
