Tuskegee Airmen Convention 2017



This year's Tuskegee Airmen Convention will be held at the Hyatt Regency Orlando Hotel in Orlando, Florida. The dates will be August 3-5. Go to taiconvention.com for registration forms. To register at the hotel, call 1-888-421-1442. Hotel room rates are good for 3 days prior to the Convention and 3 days after. The group code is TUSKEGEE AIRMEN. You may also register online. A single/double room is \$115/night plus tax. Full convention registration will admit you to all the functions. The cost is \$375 per person. Administrative registration includes the convention materials and all general, military, and joint sessions. Luncheons and the Gala are not included. The cost is \$175 per person. Youths 12 and under may register for \$125. They can attend the Military/Diversity Luncheon, Heritage Luncheon, Youth Luncheon, Grand Gala, and convention materials. You can register in person at the convention. Scooters are provided free to DOTAs and at a discounted rate for other attendees. In addition to the convention, Orlando is the center for fun

boasting beaches, fine restaurants, and many amusement parks.
