


### Lew and Scott Anderson - Lime Rock Park, CT - 8/4

Son Scott and I went up for a "**Tapas Day**" driving session on August 4. (I didn't know, but "Tapas" is Spanish for an "appetizer or sample".) It's a 2-hour session of driving your own car on the racetrack at Lime Rock. No helmets or tech inspections required. Highlights:

- 1) You drive your own car under supervision of a track supplied instructor or leader along with a helper.
- 2) Typical group size is 10 cars. Ours was 8, two people cancelled probably due to rain in the forecast that day. Cars were Scott and I in our two 911s, BMW 2dr sedan, Mercedes sedan, Volvo station wagon, Mustang, Kia, Miata.
- 3) Each driver is given a 2-way radio for listening to the instructor. (no transmitting)
- 4) The first hour is spent on a smaller section of the autocross course.
  - A. 2 cars are on the course at one time. Each group had 3 sessions of about 4 or 5 laps each.
  - B. The instructor stands in the middle of the course and coaches you over the radio. (eg "turn in now," "brake harder," "go faster" etc.)
- 5) The second hour is on the road racing course.
  - A. Lead/follow with the instructor in the lead car, talking to you on the radio.
  - B. Top speed is limited to approximately 95 mph I would guess.
  - C. The lead car behind the instructor drops back to the end of the line each lap so everyone gets a chance to be right behind the instructor.

One of these sessions is certainly not a substitute for a day of driver education, but in my case, it was a good way for an old man to show that he can find his way around a race course. I did driver education several times a year for 20 years with the last time in 2006. I really enjoyed the experience, brief as it was. 






# Birthdays at the Beach - 8/28 - Bill Tice!

The Harrier hovered on it's jet exhaust. We left before the delayed Thunderbird display.


