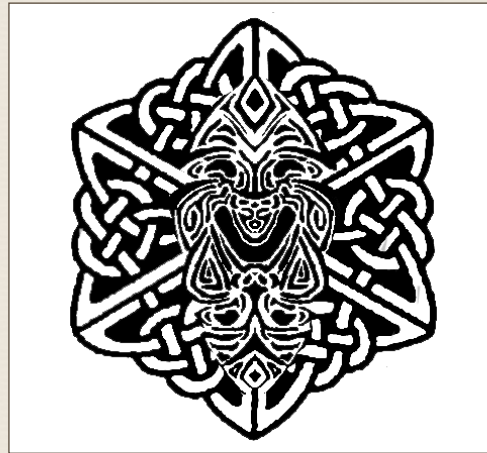

THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

- (1) You must have no other God but me.
- (2) You must not make idols or worship them.
- (3) You must not use the Lord’s name in vain.
- (4) You must remember the Sabbath & keep it Holy.
- (5) You must honor your father and mother.
- (6) You must not kill.
- (7) You must not commit adultery.
- (8) You must not steal.
- (9) You must not be a false witness or testify falsely.
- (10) You must not covet other people’s lives or stuff.

THE GOLDEN RULE

JESUS SAID IT BEST

MATT. 5 : 17 - 19

I tell you the truth, until heaven and earth disappear, not even the smallest detail of God’s law will disappear *until its purpose is achieved.*

So if you ignore the least commandment and teach others to do the same, you will be called the least in the Kingdom of Heaven.

But anyone who obeys God’s laws and teaches them will be called great in the Kingdom of Heaven.” -Jesus

Jesus showed us that unconditional love is the path to living the law in all its nuances.
