#### Meeting

The monthly meetings will be held in person at the **Southeast Community Training Center** located at 195 U S Highway 84 West in Daleville on the **fourth Thursday** of the month at **6 pm**. There is a weekly club net check ins on Thursdays at 7 pm on the K2DAL repeater.

#### **K2DAL** Repeater

The K2DAL repeater equipment is owned by the Dale EMS and Rescue Squad and is a partnership project with the Daleville Amateur Radio Service / Dale County Amateur Radio Emergency Service. The repeater was coordinated with the Alabama Repeater Council to ensure there will be no interference. The repeater downlink is 147.345 and the uplink is 147.945. The tone in and out is 123.0. This repeater has emergency backup power and is linked to EchoLink as K2DAL-R. This repeater is primarily for ARES® and assisting emergency services, however when not in use by ARES®, we welcome and encourage its use by licensed amateur radio operators.

There will be a **weekly check in on Thursdays at 7 pm.** All licensed amateur radio operators are welcome to check in. All licensed amateur radio operators are also welcome to check in to the **ARES net on Sundays at 3 pm.**
