Three Keys to Success in the Boardman Band

As you begin your journey with the Boardman Band, I'd like to share three principles that will help make your experience successful. While talent and experience are valuable, these three traits are far more important in determining both individual and group success.

1. Accountability

Being part of a great team means being a great team member.

In the Boardman Band, accountability means taking ownership of your responsibilities. This includes bringing all required materials to rehearsal, arriving early and prepared to begin on time, taking care of your instrument, equipment, and uniform, and performing your role to the best of your ability.

Accountability also includes staying on top of communications and schedules. We believe students are ultimately responsible for knowing when and where they need to be and for paying attention to the information that is provided to them. At the same time, we recognize that these skills take time to develop. As a team of staff members and parents, we will support students as they learn to manage their responsibilities and prepare themselves for success.

When everyone does their part, great things can happen.

2. Discipline

Discipline means doing the little things every day that lead to success.

This includes practicing regularly, participating fully, paying attention to details, and following through on commitments. Success in band is rarely the result of one great effort. More often, it comes from consistent effort over time.

Do your best each day to be a little better than you were the day before. Small improvements add up quickly, and the results can be remarkable.

3. Attitude

A positive attitude is one of the most valuable things a band member can bring to the organization.

Great band members are teachable, open to instruction, and willing to learn from both successes and mistakes. They understand that they are part of something larger than themselves and are willing to put the needs of the group first when necessary.

When a group of people shares a positive attitude and a commitment to a common goal, remarkable things can happen.

1. Band uniform pick-up starts on the BPAC stage.

Marching Band Students will pay the uniform fee of \$50, purchase any additional items (see #2b for details), and pay any outstanding balances.

****To avoid bookkeeping confusion, we ask that you be prepared to make separate payments for things like band account balances, fundraising, etc. If you are paying by check, it is best practice not to fill out the check until you are at uniform pick-up.**

2. The band uniform can be categorized into 3 parts:

- a. Rented: The marching and concert uniforms that will be fitted during uniform pick-up. Most students get both.
- b. Student-owned: Buy from the school - these are official uniform items that are only available from the school. Most of the items are needed by all band members. These items will be available for sale during uniform pick-up.
 - Band short-sleeve t-shirt \$10 - the only short-sleeve shirt worn under the marching uniform.
 - Band polo shirt \$20 - required shirt for the summer uniform.
 - Gloves \$5 - required for the marching uniform (first pair is free).
 - Dinkles marching band shoes \$45 - required for the marching and summer uniforms.

Optional items include:

- Band long sleeve t-shirt \$15 - for under the marching fb uniform
- Winter hat - \$18
- Headband - \$2

- c. Student owned: Purchase on your own - Most of these items are needed by all band members and each student will need to get on their own.
- Black, calf-length socks - required for the marching and summer uniforms
 - Black dress pants - required for the summer uniform - **No leggings, jeans, or knit/sweatpants.**
 - Black belt - required for the summer uniform
 - Any items specific to the concert uniform will be announced during concert season

*** SILKS ONLY:** Nude Bodysuit - must be worn under new uniform

3. Silks and Sweethearts have different uniform requirements, but at a minimum, will need to pay the \$25 uniform fee.

**The shoes are \$40 for Silks. Speak with your advisor for more information.*

4. Marching Band Students will be fitted for their uniforms during the first week of full band practice (July 27th-July 30th), and the uniform fee must be paid by Weds, August 5th, in order to be in the band pictures on Thursday, August 13th.

TO REQUEST AN EXCUSED ABSENCE:



Submit an **Excusal Request Form** available on the Boardman Band website.



Requests should be submitted at least **TWO WEEKS IN ADVANCE** whenever possible. Approval is granted at the discretion of the directors.



In the event of an emergency or illness, email the band directors as soon as possible so we are aware of the absence.

PARTICIPATION BY 8TH GRADERS IS THROUGH INVITATION BY THE BAND STAFF ONLY

This is an awesome opportunity for students who have shown every day in band over the last four years that they are playing music at an advanced level and are, and demonstrate maturity that would make them eligible to participate in a high school activity



With that being said, this is in fact a high school activity, so we will expect a high school level of maturity, performance, and participation.



If at any point in time the staff feels that the student might not be ready yet, we hold the right to hit pause on participation until next year.
