Family Day at the Park fundraiser for Duette one-room schoolhouse April 16

Duette residents, some whose families have lived in the immediate area since the early 1800s, have reactivated the Duette Community Association in a bid to gain possession of the last one-room schoolhouse in Florida.

The tight-knit community, located near the head waters of the Manatee River, hope to procure the building for community use. Some of the ideas mentioned include a museum, a place for summer youth programs, a community center and library with computers.

To help raise funds, there will be a Family Day at the Park on Saturday, April 16, at Bunker Hill Park, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Food and drink will be provided and arts and crafts will be among the activities.
