PANTRY NEWS

The pantry is still seeing a reduced number of guests, probably due to people still receiving extra SNAP benefits, and stimulus checks. However new people continue to come in on most distribution days. Many new people say they did not realize they are eligible for services. Other agencies, along with friends of these people, refer them to the pantry.

The income guidelines are still at the increased level of 200% of poverty, so there are many people who do not realize they are eligible. The pantry does not ask for proof of income, only that people who receive food acknowledge they are below the guidelines.

If anyone is wondering if they, or someone they know, are eligible they can contact the pantry during operation hours. The guidelines can also be found on-line.

The pantry continues to wait for final approval of plans to the beginning of the expansion. Good things come to those who wait, Right!
