All is going well at the pantry. There are still new people coming every week to use the pantry. Numbers are still lower than usual, but everyone served is very appreciative. The main reason we think numbers are lower is that people receiving SNAP are getting more money due to the covid-19 relief.

In fact, one generous couple called saying they had received more in SNAP than they could use for the month, so they went to Walmart and bought a large quantity of food which they donated to the pantry. What a wonderful gesture of kindness and generosity.

There have been several other generous food and monetary donations made. The pantry always needs these donations, no matter the size or amount.

We had two women from Paris come to the pantry to observe our operation. These women are planning to open a second food pantry in Paris, and were told our pantry was a good one to see in action! Todd was able to provide much needed information to them. Thank you to the Easter Illinois Foodbank for referring our pantry. It is reassuring to us that we are doing a good job. Think we knew that, but always nice to get a "pat on the back"!
