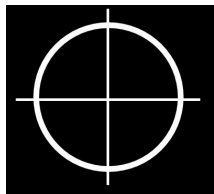
The Quest to Become Recovered

- At the heart of the Gospel (which means "good news") of Jesus Christ is the reality that sin (missing the mark of God's glory as shown in the image of Christ), in our case...the manifestations of active addiction and the life-controlling/self-destructive behaviors and patterns we exhibit in our lives which effects the lives of others around us...CANNOT be cured by simply changing outward behaviors.
- Sin and addiction can only be overcome by the power of God working from the inside out...by allowing the Holy Spirit to apply the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus Christ to our human spirits and souls.
- Nothing from the outside world can make us whole, healed or satisfied! Only Jesus Christ can transform us from the inside out!



Beginning the Quest:

At the very center of the Gospel of Jesus Christ is the reality that sin (missing the mark of God's glory as shown in the image of Christ) cannot be cured by simply changing outward behaviors. Sin can only be overcome by the POWER of God working from the inside out. This happens when the Spirit of God applies the death, burial and resurrection of Christ to our human hearts.

Jesus lived for us. Jesus died for us. Jesus was buried in a tomb and rose again on the third day. Jesus will return for us. This is the simple gospel message.

"Well, I am not religious." Good! We aren't either! We are asking you if you have a relationship with your Creator.

We are simply asking you to "surrender as much of yourself as you can to as much of Christ as you understand."

THE BIG PICTURE

(God's Will and Purpose)

- **CREATION:** God created everything. We were made in His image for dominion.
- **FALL:** Through sin (missing the mark of God's glory as shown in the image of Christ), His image is distorted in us, but not lost. We seek to "cover" our sins with various addictions and life-controlling/self-destructive behaviors.
- **REDEMPTION:** Redemption in Christ is a progressive re-covering of God's image.
- **RETURN:** At Christ's return we will experience complete recovery of His image. We will experience complete salvation...spirit, soul and body.

THE BIG, SMALL PICTURE

(GOD'S Will/Purpose VS. SELF will/purpose)

- **BROKENNESS:** We turn back to God.
- **CONVICTION, CONFESSION, CLEANSING:** We cast out the sins from our lives.
- **AMENDS/RESTITUTION:** We make right the wrongs of our pasts.
- **PRAYER:** We talk to God.
- **OBEDIENCE:** We keep His commandments.
- **WORSHIP:** We worship the Creator and not the creation.
- **ENDURE TEMPTATION:** We take all thoughts captive to Christ.
- **REACH OUT TO OTHERS:** We share with others our experience, strength, and hope.
- **QUIET TIME:** We commit daily time with God in prayer, reflection and Bible study.
- **DIVINE GUIDANCE:** We listen for God to speak.
