OUR HISTORY, AS WE KNOW IT

Mattie Jane Wilkins was born in 1875 in Travis County, Texas to John and Mary (Maltsberger) Wilkins. Mattie Jane lived in Texas with her parents, three brothers, and two sisters until the mid-1890s.

During the early 1890s, Mattie Jane's bother, Oscar, began working on the cattle drives from Texas to the North Indian Territory. His stories of new opportunities and of "fortunes to be made" by providing services to those working for and using the railroad prompted the family to make another move

The family traveled from Texas to Muskogee in covered wagons to join Oscar and create a new life. Mattie Jane told many stories of her adventures and encounters during the journey to Oklahoma to her grandchildren.

The Wilkins Family bought property near the stockyards on Cherokee Street and opened up a boarding house/hotel in Muskogee. In 1897, Mattie Jane married Joseph Sanborn, a foreman for the stockyards and the Katy Railroad. In 1902, Mattie Jane and Joe's first daughter, Ada Ruth, was born in Muskogee, Indian Territory. Their second daughter, Helen Marguerite, arrived in 1911. Helen was born in the new state of Oklahoma. Both Ada and Helen were lifetime residents of Muskogee.

Mattie Jane was a true pioneer woman who loved life and her family. She was known for her spunky spirit and infectious laughter. She was a legendary family member whose antics and stories were passed down for generations. Mattie Jane lived in Muskogee until her death in 1949.

Six generations of the Wilkins family have resided in Muskogee and are still serving the local community today.
