FORMAT OF COMPETITION

- PRELIMINARY ROUND. (Teams divided into 2 zones)
- Teams play each other ONCE within their respective zones. Top 4 teams from each zone advance to the Quarter-final.

QUARTER-FINAL

ZONE A 2ND place and 3RD place exchanges places with ZONE B 2ND and 3RD PLACE teams.

Teams play each other once in their respective zones. **Top two (2) teams advance to the BEST OF THREE SEMI-FINALS.**

SEMIFINAL ROUND (BEST OF 3)

1ST ZONE A vs 2ND ZONE B, 1ST ZONE B vs 2ND ZONE A. Winners advance to the best of 3 Finals. Losers advance to the 3rd and 4th placings

FINALS - BEST OF 3 FINALS.

- Winner SEMIFINAL A vs Winner SEMIFINAL B

COMPETITION GUIDELINES

The competition is administered by the ISSA with the support of the JABA.

- ❖ A member of staff MUST accompany all teams.
- ❖ All team members MUST present a valid ISSA's ID at all games. **
- ❖ All coach must be JABA certified.
- ❖ All schools MUST have at least two (2) certified table officials.
- ❖ All referee fees must be made payable by cheque to ISSA
- ❖ Home teams are named first. Home teams sits to the left of the scorer's table.
- ❖ Home teams are responsible to prepare and clean up before and after games.
- ❖ In cases where there are two games, the host team will prepare venue for both games.
- ❖ Only team followers and games officials are allowed on the side of the court where the scorer table is placed. Host team can forfeit game if they fail to control spectators
- ❖ Each team is responsible to keep bench area clean during and after games.
- ❖ Teams hosting games must have the following:
 - ❖ 2 stopwatches
 - ❖ 5 foul bats or indicators mark 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5
 - ❖ 2 cones or desk flags to indicate team fouls
 - ❖ 1 visible chalkboard or score board
 - ❖ 2 team benches
- ❖ REFRESHMENTS FOR BOTH TEAMS AND OFFICIALS
- ❖ 1 assistant scorer to place the score on the scoreboard
- ❖ Access to telephone for scores to be release to the media houses.
- ❖ Score and Statistic sheets (Issue from office of ISSA)

NB:

- ✚ Petitions for postponement of games must get the approval of ISSA and or the National Coordinator. Petition must be submitted in writing at least two weeks prior to request date for consideration. Requests made after will NOT be considered.
- ✚ Postponed games will be rescheduled on the next available Saturday
- ✚ Teams forfeiting games will be fined in the first instant without gaining points.
- ✚ A second forfeiture will result in the team being expelled from the competition.
- ✚ No player will be allowed to play on two teams at the same time during the season.
- ✚ Only properly uniformed player (under FIBA rules) will be allowed on the court for game.
